CONVENIENCE

- For residence hall residents, only one bill instead of several each month for rent, gas, electric, trash, food and internet (payments can be made through the student's university billing account)
- Located within walking distance of classes, with a free shuttle service for Jardine Apartments residents to use if they wish
- Convenience stores, restaurants, coffee shops and a bakery on site
- On-site laundry facilities
- With a meal plan, food is prepared by trained professionals from menus developed by registered dietitians (plus, no dishes!)

- Free technical assistance with computers, smartphones and game consoles for all residents
- Wireless internet access points in room and throughout building
- An academic year contract for the residence halls instead of a 12-month contract
- Furniture provided in the residence halls and Hybrid Apartments: lofting/bunking extra-long twin bed, desk and chair, trash can, and dresser or built-in drawers for every resident

PEACE OF MIND

- A staff of more than 300 full-time professionals to serve residents (one full-time staff member for every 17 students)
