CONVENIENCE

- For residence hall residents, only one bill instead of several each month for rent, gas, electric, trash, food and internet (payments can be made through the student's university billing account)
- Located within walking distance of classes, with a free shuttle service for Jardine Apartments residents to use if they wish
- Convenience stores, restaurants, coffee shops and a bakery on site
- On-site laundry facilities
- With a meal plan, food is prepared by trained professionals from menus developed by registered dietitians (plus, no dishes!)
- Opportunities to work where you live

SUCCESS

- Higher average GPAs than those of off-campus students
- Higher graduation rates for students who live on campus
- Several organizations dedicated to providing students with extracurricular leadership opportunities, such as the National Residence Hall Honorary, the Association of Residence Halls and the Hall Governing Board
- A student success center to assist students with coursework

VALUE

- Free technical assistance with computers, smartphones and game consoles for all residents
- Wireless internet access points in room and throughout building
- An academic year contract for the residence halls instead of a 12-month contract
- Furniture provided in the residence halls and Hybrid Apartments: lofting/bunking extra-long twin bed, desk and chair, trash can, and dresser or built-in drawers for every resident
- A variety of room types and rates
- Printing services, free internet and academic support
- Dietitians to help you make choices that are right for you at the dining center

PEACE OF MIND

- A staff of full-time professionals to serve residents (one full-time staff member for every 17 students)
- Maintenance staff of more than 100, who provide 24-hour assistance
- Graduate assistant staff: A master's degree-level professional staff member in each hall and in each apartment neighborhood
- Resident assistant staff working to ensure residents' needs are met
- Locked doors 24 hours a day, with a staffed front desk at each residence hall
